Athletic Activities	May 23 rd – Conditioning and skill drills may be conducted with no contact.
Athletic Fields	Jun 15 th – Games can commence with restrictions. Detailed State Guidelines
Camps	May 23 rd – Can be held with restrictions. Detailed State Guidelines
Child day-care facilities	May 23 rd – Removed limit on children with restrictions. Detailed State Guidelines
Educational Institutions	June 1 st – May open with restrictions. Detailed State Guidelines
Entertainment Venues	May 23 rd – Jefferson County – Must remain closed until June 6th. See Detailed Order Shelby Co - Can open with 50% occupancy & other restrictions Detailed State Guidelines

Hoover Library	June 1 st – Curbside service opens. Call (205) 444-7800 for details.
Hoover Met Complex	May 23 rd – Tennis Courts open for reservations May 26 th – Pickleball - Lacrosse / Soccer / Multi-Purpose Fields available for PRACTICE ONLY - Baseball / Softball / Basketball / Volleyball PRACTICE ONLY See www.hoovermetcomplex.com for times and other restrictions.
Municipal Courts	June 2 nd - Resume court operations
Hoover Recreation Center	May 26 th – Racquetball by reservation - Gymnasium open with max occupancy of 12, must bring own equipment - Restrooms and changing area open. Locker rooms and showers remain closed
Hoover Sports Parks	May 23 rd – Fields/hitting facilities open with restrictions Detailed State Guidelines Jun 15 th – Parks open for games and tournaments with restrictions
NO CHANGES	
Athletic Facilities / Gyms	Open with restrictions. No locker room or shower access. Detailed State Guidelines
Close Contact Services (Hair Salons, tattoo/massage parlors)	Open but must maintain 6ft social distancing and sanitation guidelines. Detailed State Guidelines
Hoover Senior Center	Remain closed; Meals on Wheels continues
Hoover Neighborhood Parks	Parks remain open including restrooms. Playgrounds remain closed.
Hospitals/Nursing homes	Restrictive visitation
Individuals	Individuals are still encouraged to stay home, practice social distancing in public and encouraged to wear face coverings when in public
Non-Work Gathering	No size restriction, but must maintain 6 ft. social distancing other than immediate family members. Guidelines for religious facilities.
Restaurants / Bars	Can open at 50% capacity and maintain social distancing guidelines. Detailed State Guidelines
Retail Stores	Retail stores can open but must remain below 50% occupancy capacity, maintain social – distancing and follow CDC sanitation guidelines. Business owners can check their occupancy capacity by contacting the Fire Marshall at 205-444-7606.
