Foundation Details

The Hoover Parks and Recreation Foundation was formed in 1991 for the purpose of promoting assisting, strengthening and advancing the quality and availability of programs and facilities for the residents of the City of Hoover. The Foundation Board of Directors consists of a minimum of five community members.

The Foundation works closely with the Parks and Recreation Department to meet the needs of the community. The Foundation solicits outside funding and hosts a variety of fundraisers to work toward the purpose. The Foundation is a non-profit organization with donations being tax deductible as allowed by law. 100% of the funds/proceeds donated to the Foundation benefit the community.

Foundation Projects

The founding project for the Foundation was the acquisition of Moss Rock Preserve.

2003 – 2009

- Established fundraising initiative for the Hoover Senior Center. *Over \$100,000 raised
- Funded installation of picnic tables and trash cans at Star Lake
- Established “Memorial Paver Program” for Veterans Park
- Developed ‘PETAPALOOZA’ fundraiser event supporting qualified Pet Rescues
- Established annual Bass Fishing Tournament as key Foundation fundraiser

2011 – 2017

- Established various fundraising events for Therapeutic Recreation
- Facilitated the transition of PETAPALOOZA to WOOFstock
- Began acceptance of Senior Center memorial donations.
- Established Annual Hoover Cup Golf Tournament as a key Foundation fundraiser
- Assisted with the design/construction costs for the Hoover East accessible playground.

2014 – 2020

- Sponsored the Veteran Memorial Arbor at Aldridge Gardens
- Added Moss Rock Preserve as a funding recipient
- Sponsored a fishing outing at Aldridge Gardens for Veterans with visual impairments
- Donated over \$15,000.00 to the EXPLORE Playground and Splash Pad

2019 – present

Giving Opportunities

Cash Donations

Most Hoover Parks and Recreation Foundation gifts are received as cash or checks. Checks should be made payable to the Hoover Parks and Recreation Foundation. All donations are tax deductible as allowed by law.

Bequests

Gifts through wills and bequests can provide opportunities to honor and sustain your family name in conjunction with the Hoover Parks and Recreation Foundation’s name recognition program. The Hoover Parks and Recreation Foundation will work with you and or your attorney to provide you with the language necessary to insure that your intentions are clearly expressed.

Life Income/Charitable Trusts

Charitable Trusts and Gift Annuities offer opportunities to make substantial gifts to the Hoover Parks and Recreation Foundation without forfeiting the annual income produced by these assets. You can retain income for your life and the life of your spouse. This gift can also be structured to create a substantial tax benefit over a period of years.

Giving through life insurance can be accomplished by 1) the transfer of ownership of an existing policy to the Hoover Parks and Recreation Foundation, or 2) the purchase of life insurance which names Hoover Parks and Recreation Foundation as the beneficiary and/or owner.
